

ANNUAL REPORT FOR NESEHNUTÍ IN 2018

The Initiative Way

We help civic initiatives, non-profit organizations, independent journalists, and human rights activists in the South Caucasus and Ukraine. **We share with them successful methods that have worked for us in the Czech Republic**, especially in the area of conducting civic campaigns aimed at systemic changes in society. **We want people in these (post-)conflict areas to live a free civic life and for their rights to be respected.**

In 2018 we organized a number of educational events and supported 19 predominantly youth initiatives. In their campaigns the supported initiatives focused on ecological issues, pay inequality, informal education of children and youth, and the issue of domestic violence.

For example, thanks to our support, drinking water quality improved in Mykolaiv, Ukraine, and in Abkhazia, journalists and non-profit organizations started to systematically pay attention to bullying at schools and to children's rights. In Armenia, for example, we cooperated with initiatives that focused on territories affected by mining or that focused on promoting the accessibility of public beaches.

Our work would not be possible without our cooperation with a wide network of young volunteers from the Czech Republic and our target regions.



Women's Rights are Human Rights

We draw attention to inequality between the status of women and men in society and the problems that entails. We also work on raising public awareness about how to deliver education in the schools without prejudice, about sexism in advertising and elsewhere, and about inequalities in the remuneration of women and men. **We refute the idea that the roles of women and men in society are clearly given and unchanging.**

In 2018 we announced the last year of the anti-award Sexist Piglet, where the public nominated 50 advertisements, and issued a publication summarizing 10 years of our work on the topic of sexism, and not just in advertising.

We focused on working with young people. We carried out workshops at secondary schools for hundreds of students as well as our second Gender Games competition, and began to develop and test new educational programs on the issue of intimate partner relationships without violence. We also involved the students themselves in the development of this work. In addition, we implemented a webinar on gender-based violence for the National Institute for Education.

On the subject of unequal pay for women and men, we organized an international conference (together with the Department for Equality of Women and Men under the Government of the Czech Republic and other partners) as well as an awareness-raising Equal Pay Day in which more than 60 businesses participated. We realized the first representative survey on sexist advertising in the Czech Republic and, last but not least, we organized an intensive personal development course for women called I *Respect Myself*. **Based on our activities, we published a number of educational and awareness-raising materials**:

- · Life stories as a mirror of inequality
- Preschool for me. How to enjoy kindergarten in a fun and sensitive way
- Did Grandma have four apples and Grandpa... five? Or what does the Czech public think of unequal pay for women and men?
- Fighting sexism 10 years of activism for non-sexist advertising
- Law versus sexism
- Analysis of the discussion about unequal pay for women and men in the Czech media



Together Towards Diversity

Our basic intention is to find opportunities for mutual understanding despite perceptions of "otherness" and **to make room for people to live together in an accommodating, tolerant society**. We put this idea into practice through our education of children and youth in primary and secondary schools, by informing the public about these issues during discussions and other public events, and also by **directly connecting newcomers to Brno with long-term residents there**.

Based on the "*buddies*" program, which creates a space for establishing friendly ties between local volunteers and newcomers, we created 30 functioning tandems last year. We then further develop the buddies' tandem system to create direct, long-term cooperation enabling exchange and help between one local and one newcomer.

We organized a city camp for children of both newcomers and locals, an intercultural soccer tournament, a two-day open conference in the format of a BarCamp, and a number of community events and workshops for kindergarteners, primary school children, and others.

Our activities would not be feasible without our long-term, continuous cooperation with our volunteers.

We are also constantly strengthening our involvement in both domestic and international networks. Within the Community Building Lab project we collaborate with 20 initiatives, and in 2018 we released a joint publication entitled *Change Begins Together: How to Create and Strengthen a Community.*

Civic Eye

We seek to promote nature conservation and landscape protection in municipalities, and we strive for a healthy environment and active civil society in Brno and elsewhere.

In 2018 we launched a unique web portal, moudramesta.cz, which aggregates ideas for courageous local governments and active citizens. Here you will learn how to prevent climate change and also how to respond to these changes in their various forms and manifestations.

Last year we repeatedly devoted our attention to sustainable transport. In the spring we joined the efforts of Brno citizens to preserve the railway station in the city center. In September, together with 725 supporters signed under our open letter, we reminded candidates in the municipal elections in Brno that sustainable transport is essential for the city's further development.

We tried to benefit the greenery and community on the street where we are based. We adopted a few flower beds in tree grates, which we look after together with our neighbors. In cooperation with other businesses, residents and organizations from the surrounding area we organized a neighborhood celebration including music and food from all around the world.

We educated others about topics such as civic participation, the effects of climate change on cities, and inclusive urban planning.

We work on our topics together with local civic volunteers who also care about the environment.



NESEHNUTÍ

We are a social and ecological non-governmental organization. The aim of our ecological and human rights activities is to show that social change based on respect for people, animals and nature is possible – and most importantly, must be led from below. Therefore, we support people who are interested and **engaged** in what is happening around them and who consider taking **responsibility** for life on our planet as an integral part of their own **freedom**.

We began 2018 by interviewing presidential candidates and actively campaigning for the preservation of the railway station in the center of Brno. We continued by organizing a two-day series of lectures and workshops in the format of a BarCamp, communicated about the topic of sustainable mobility on the streets of Brno, had fun at a neighborhood festival, tried to remove militarism from schools during the Week against the Militarization of Youth, said goodbye to our final year of the Sexist Piglet anti-award, all the while traveling to help civic initiatives abroad. **Throughout the year we were organizing workshops and community events, releasing publications and building a network of active volunteers.**



Disarmament Group (Odzbrojovka)

We advocate for a free, secure society as an alternative to a society that is militarized. We believe that armaments, border fortifications and human rights abuses do not lead to security, but that dialogue, understanding contexts, and actions taken for the sake of justice and equality for all will make us secure. We strive for disarmament at both the level of action and at the level of thought.

In 2018, among other things, we decided to change the name of this group from the original "Weapons or Human Rights" to "*Odzbrojovka*", which translates as something like "Disarmament Factory".

As part of our activities in 2018, we drew attention to arms exports from the Czech Republic. We monitored media outputs and official documents relating to this topic. On the International Day of Peace, we released our Report on Arms Exports from the Czech Republic. We also coordinated the nationwide Week against Militarization of Youth event. At the music festival in Boskovice we gave public lectures on the topic of arms exports. We organized thematic workshops on this issue for adults, children and youth. We also provided such a workshop to the training program for engaged youth called "Accumulator".

Support Animal Rights

We focus mainly on livestock factory farms – be it with respect to animal welfare, which industrial agriculture does not take into account, or with respect to the effects of large-scale factory farming on the environment and climate change.

We began 2018 by joining the Freedom for Animals organization and addressing candidates for the President of the Czech Republic with questions regarding their relationship to the issue of animal rights. Almost a quarter of a million Facebook users then saw the infographics we created on this subject. In 2018, we also launched a unique website, hlavanahlave.cz, where, among other things, a map of the 2,016 large farms currently registered in the Czech Republic is published.

Last year we became part of a pan-European coalition of more than 100 organizations that strive to end the use of cages in farming livestock across the EU. In September we launched a year-long campaign, End the Cage Age, by staging a "happening" on Freedom Square in Brno about this issue, and for the rest of the year we collected signatures under the European Citizens' Initiative to ban cage breeding. A million signatures across the EU should convince the European Commission to take this move.

Our volunteers

Cooperation with volunteers is crucial for NESEHNUTÍ. We are very grateful that more than 50 enthusiastic people help us regularly and long-term with all our activities. Volunteers provide us with their help in translating texts, proofreading, realizing events in public spaces, searching for contacts, media monitoring and graphic work. This year we launched a new volunteer site and organized several informal meetings where we had a chance to get to know each other better. At the same time we organized training for 30 volunteers from the buddies' program on the topics of how to increase their intercultural competences and teaching the Czech language to non-native speakers. We enable our active, long-term volunteers to participate in all-organizational trainings on a variety of topics.
